Fact Cars 19 and 20 collided at Turn 1.

Offence Alleged breach of Article 16.1 d) of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action is warranted.

Reason The stewards took into account that this was the first turn of the first lap, cars 77, 19 and 20 were entering Turn 1 and it appears the driver of car 19 was concentrating on car 77.

There was no intentional turning in by car 19 on car 20.

Car 19 's rear right wheels impacted with the left front of car 20.
